

- 2. A Buyer's Premium of 13% will be added to the high bid, the total being the purchase price. SC sales tax (8%) will be added where applicable.
- 3. The credit/debit card in your profile will be charged at the conclusion of the auction. Please check your profile now and be sure that your information is current and up to date.
- 4. Beginning at 7:00 PM on TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 2022, three lots will close each minute; individual lots that receive a bid in the final few minutes will have bidding extended.
- 5. Preview dates & times are: SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 11, 2022, 3-5PM, and TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 2022, 3-5PM. Preview location: 60 CHURCH COURT, SUMTER, SC. We welcome and encourage you to inspect all lots! We encourage you to take whatever precautions you deem appropriate with regard to the pandemic.
